Eligibility Criteria:

- All genders having domicile of Punjab, are eligible for admission.
- The candidates with at least 45% marks in FA/F.Sc./I.Com/ICS or equivalent examination are eligible to apply for all programmes except B.Sc. Civil Engineering Technology where at least 50% marks are required. However, for DPT, Medical Health Professional Programmes (Medical Lab Technology (MLT), Radiography & Imaging Technology (RIT), where at least 60% marks are required as per the requirement of the respective Councils.
- The **maximum age limit** of the candidate is 24 years on the closing date of Applications.
- Admission will be granted strictly on merit i.e. on the basis of the marks obtained in FA/F.Sc./I.Com/ICS or equivalent examinations in 2021. However, candidates of the earlier sessions will be considered by deducting 10 marks for each year for admission.
- Pre requisites:
The following pre requisites have been approved for the following undergraduate programmes with the condition that the candidate must have studied these subjects at secondary or higher secondary level for respective programmes:

BS Radiography & Imaging Technology	F.Sc pre-medical or equivalent with 60% marks F.Sc RIT with 60% marks
Doctor of physical Therapy	F.Sc pre-medical or equivalent with 60% marks

DISCIPLINE AND CONDUCT REGULATIONS

- **These Regulations may be called the institute's Student Discipline and Conduct Regulations, 2021.**
- **These Regulations shall come into force with immediate effect.**
- **These Regulations shall apply to all students on the rolls of the Institute.**

ACT OF INDISCIPLINE AND MISCONDUCT

The following, violation of the provision of the code of conduct shall constitute acts of indiscipline and misconduct for which action may appropriate penalties on the defaulter:

(a) Breach of rules of public morals, such as:

- i. Use of indecent or filthy language in class rooms, residential halls, play grounds and on the Campus;
- ii. Use of immodest, improper and provocative dress;
- iii. Use of undesirable remarks or gestures;
- iv. Disorderly behavior, such as shouting, abusing, quarreling, fighting and insolence;

- v. Any student misbehaving with a teacher / and or Official of the Institute;
- vi. Use or attempt or threat to use force;
- vii. Damage to Property or its Destruction: Intentionally or recklessly destroying or damaging, or attempting to destroy or damage, University property or the property of others on University premises or at University-sponsored activities;
- viii. Impersonation purgery, giving false information, willful Suppressions of information, cheating, deceiving and stealing;
- ix. Entrance in the university premises without student card;
- x. Involvement in political activities;

PENALTIES

- Censure and warning for future.
- Withdrawal of financial concessions for one semester.
- Imposition of fines depending upon the nature of offence.
- Recovery of loss or breakage of movable and Institute University property.
- Placing a student on probation.
- Suspension from the rolls, and ban on entry in the premises of the Institute.
- Exclusion from the Class Room, Laboratory, Clinics, Field work for the periods concerned.
- Exclusion from Study or Sports Tours.
- Suspension or removal from a position of authority in the Institute Sports.
- Fine up to Rs.5000/-.
